

## Four-Year-Old Curriculum

The four-year-old (also referred to as “Pre-K”) curriculum was developed with “whole child” learning in mind to prepare our children for Kindergarten. An emphasis is placed on the development of **fine motor, large motor, cognitive learning and school preparedness skills such as numbers, phonemic awareness, colors, shapes and letter/sound relationships.** We offer “hands-on” experiences and the opportunity to learn while having fun.
